



## TECHNICAL STAFF COACH (P/T)

### Overview

The Abbotsford Soccer Association is currently seeking applications for the position of Technical Staff Coach (Two positions available).

A variety of opportunities are available within several programs that run throughout the calendar year. Individuals will work as part of the ASA Technical Committee and in cooperation with other technical staff, under the guidance of the club Technical Director & Coach Development Manager. Staff Coaches are responsible for the delivery of age-specific training sessions, in keeping with the ASA Playing Concept & Philosophy. These individuals should be highly motivated and have ambitions to continue their own personal development in achieving the necessary Canada Soccer Licenses, as well attending and facilitating at the ASA In-House Coach Education & Development sessions.

### Duties & Responsibilities

- Provide High-Level Training for competitive teams that follows the established Periodized Training Plan
- Utilize coaching resources and software to help plan and manage training sessions
- Report progress and results to Technical Director
- Establish yearly plan for Teams (to include Tournaments).
- Conduct match preparation meetings and analysis with team
- Provide additional technical training for other club teams within the coach's primary age group
- Be available for additional training programs offered by the club
- Provide player assessments/feedback to players & families

### Competencies & Skills Required

- Minimum CSA/BCSA C License
- Experience as a coach and/or player within a professional club or university environment
- Understanding of BC Soccer Player Development practices and standards or similar
- Knowledge of and support for the Canadian Soccer Association's Long-Term Player Development (LTPD) model and Wellness to World Cup framework.
- Experience with coaching both male and female players and the design of associated technical programs
- Knowledge of elite player development systems
- Experience with and a passion for personal education and development
- An understanding of the structure of competitive youth soccer and how it relates to optimal player development.
- Knowledge of the Canadian soccer landscape
- An ability to think and plan strategically
- Strong communications skills and an ability to convey messages to parents, players and club staff
