Re: Return to Play – Preparing for Phase 2 of Soccer – Information Gathering

Dear Full/Associate Members and Affiliated Clubs,

We are pleased to share that several members and affiliated clubs have been following the Return to Play in Phase 1 mandatory steps with over 60 having completed Canada Soccer's Return to Play Assessment Tool, which is very encouraging!

BC Soccer understands that the Members and Affiliated Clubs' have the collective desire for clarity on timelines for future phases. We want this clarity as well and are working with ViaSport on this. Importantly, any further steps will be in accordance with the Provincial Health Authority's (care of Via Sport) guidance and direction. Nevertheless, as we prepare for potential next steps we would like to, again, gather input from the soccer community. To achieve this, we have prepared the "Return to Play Phase 2 for Soccer - Information Gathering Survey" linked below.

Similar to last time, we kindly ask that each organization provide their feedback through one survey response and ask you not to distribute to your respective end-user/participants. As the situation still changes on a daily basis, we are requesting your organization's response by end of day Monday, June 22nd so we can continue to plan and be prepared to act as quickly as responsible.
