Re: Provincial Health Authority Announcement from November 7, 2020

Dear Full/Associate Members and Affiliated Clubs,

During BC Soccer's Annual General Meeting held today, we were made aware of an announcement made by the BC Health Authority and specifically Dr. Henry.

We have been in contact with ViaSport, the body that provides direction to the sport sector in BC and is the link between the BC Health Authority and the BC Sport Sector. ViaSport has confirmed they are working to provide clarity regarding the recent announcement.

Our current understanding of the announcement/order is the following.

- It is effective for two-weeks, ending November 23, 2020,
- It applies solely to the Fraser and Vancouver Coastal Health Regions,
- Indoor soccer can only occur under [BC Soccer Phase 1 Guidelines](#),
- Outdoor soccer can occur, however, travel specific to those two health regions may be impacted.

Based on the announcement, and discussions today with ViaSport, it is not clear if team travel may occur between the Fraser and Vancouver Coastal Health Regions, or if team travel should be limited to solely within one of the Regions.

BC Soccer is waiting for clarity on this from ViaSport. Once received, we will communicate to the members and affiliated clubs as quickly as possible and until then, BC Soccer is advising members/clubs that we are status quo.

Thank you for your patience and support as we continue to work through these difficult times.
