Club Coach - U9 - U18 Grassroots Recreational (Part-Time)

Position Summary

Do you have a passion for developing a “Soccer for Life” culture among youth ranging from U9 - U18? Are you creative, an excellent communicator, and a self-directed organizational guru? If you answered yes, then this opportunity may be for you!

You will support the Technical Lead in the development and delivery of a progressive soccer program that has retention and engagement as the primary indicators of success. You will take the lead in supporting grassroots recreational players and coaches in both on-field sessions and off-field logistics administration. You’ll also work collaboratively with the Technical Lead and other club coaches to support the competitive programs at U12 and above. You may also support the NUFC academies, extra development sessions, spring & summer sessions.

Key Relationships

- Reports to the NUFC Technical Lead.
- Coordinates the U9 - U18 Recreation programs, including player, parent & coach liaison.
- Working relationships include the technical lead, admin lead, club coaches and volunteer coaches.
- Regularly directs and supports volunteer or other paid session coaches.
- Occasionally interacts with members of the board of directors or other volunteers

Primary Duties

Primary duties include, but are not limited to:

- Assist the Technical Lead in the development and delivery of the NUFC soccer program
- Serve as the primary lead and point of contact for U9 - U18 Recreational programs.
- Play a primary role in communicating with players, parents and coaches.
- Support the design and delivery of the NUFC coaching syllabus from U9-U18 Rec.
- Support the Technical Lead in the delivery of coach education programs and sessions
- Assists the Technical Lead in the delivery of some or all of the NUFC Academies, extra player development sessions and spring & summer sessions.
- Attend meetings with Technical Lead, board members, coaches and parents as and when required
- Assist in the management and organization of all club equipment and uniforms, particularly relating to the U4 - U8 Grassroots Recreational groups.

Required Certification and Experience

- Minimum 3 years coaching experience
- Preferred BC Soccer Pre B / C License or higher
- Expectation of ongoing coaching professional development

Requirements

- Current (within the last 3 years) criminal record check
- Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders and Respect in the Workplace training completed within 2 weeks of hire
- Access to your own transportation

Salary, Work Schedule and Term

- \$16,000 - \$30,000 (based on experience) per year assuming an average of 20 hours per week. Exact schedule to be determined by the Technical Lead and will vary depending on the season. Most work is during evenings and on weekends. Must be available on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings as well as Saturday mornings.
- Position to start as soon as possible and run to July 31, 2021 with possibility of annual renewal.

- There is the potential that this position may become full-time based on the potential of additional contract work with other clubs or sporting organizations.
