## **YOUTH PROVINCIAL CUP CODE OF CONDUCT**

### *Application of the Policy*

This Policy applies to all members of the team including all participating athletes, coaches, team managers and parents. This Policy applies to conduct of such members at Provincial Competitions activities and events.

### *Code of Conduct*

All participants at BC Soccer Provincial Championships are expected to:

- i. Act as ambassadors for their local clubs, districts and leagues
- ii. Participate in the Provincial Championships in the spirit of fair play, co-operation and respect for others at all times
- iii. Comply with rulings by officials, coaches, managers, or any other person in a position of authority or responsibility
- iv. Respect and adhere to the British Columbia Soccer Association Competitions Rules and Regulations
- v. Perform to their best ability in every competition and accept with pride the result their effort brings
- vi. Respect the rights of the residents of the Host Association and members from other clubs, districts, and leagues
- vii. Regard participation in the Provincial Championships as a privilege
- viii. Obey all federal laws, provincial laws and municipal by-laws, on alcohol consumption and illegal substance (drug) and tobacco use;
- ix. Respect the Zero Tolerance of alcohol (acquiring, possession of purchasing or consuming) at Provincial Youth Championships
- x. Not abuse, damage or destroy facilities or equipment.
- xi. Adhere to the Judicial Code and Policies of BC Soccer

All players, team officials and at least one parent/guardian for each player must sign the BC Soccer Code of Conduct prior to competing in any BC Soccer Provincial Cup Competition. A completed Youth Provincial Cup Code of Conduct signifies that all players, team officials and parents/guardians agree to abide by the code.

Violations of BC Soccer's Judicial Code & Policies, Youth Provincial Cup Code of Conduct or Social Media Policy will be referred to the Judicial Chair for that competition and may result in immediate suspension from the tournament.
